Clean covered flat performance area with minimum dimensions of:

8' high, 14' wide and 14' deep

45 minutes set-up time, prior to show, and 30 minutes break down time, after the show

Recommended performance space: cafeteria, auditorium or gym

Tables and chairs must be pushed back or to the side to clear floor space for student audience to sit on the floor.

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Students will go on a voyage through the Pacific Islands in three legends meeting "Iawame" the forest god in the New Guinea tale "The Discontented Crow," a foolish and lazy woman in a tale from Fiji called "The Woman Who Wanted to Cook with Salt Water" and finally travel to Hawai'i to see Maui the demi-god in "How Maui Slowed the Sun." These legends will sail students to days long ago through magnificent storytelling, music and memorable characters.
